


The Gulfport-Biloxi International Airport Site is comprised of 241 developable acres that is adjacent to the airport's 9,002 ft runway and has an existing taxiway to the north end of the property if access is required. Owned by the airport, it's strategically within two miles of I-10 and the Port of Gulfport, allowing convenient access to the Gulf of Mexico flight test range for commercial and unmanned aerial vehicle testing. One-hundred twenty-six of the 241-acres has received permitting and has been cleared and leveled.
